How Retail Business Computing has Evolved



- The first cash register was invented and patented in the late 1800's.
- National Cash Register (NCR) designed an electric cash register in 1906.
- International Business Machine (IBM) invented the first computer-driven cash register in 1973.
- The first Windows-based retail POS software was developed in the early 1990s.
- Improved internet speeds in the 2000s allowed software of all kinds including POS to be available in the cloud.





What's in the Cloud?



Cloud-based services allow businesses to utilize a service provider's programs, digital services, or platform hardware through internet connections. The three most prominent forms are:

- SaaS software
- IaaS IT infrastructure such as Microsoft Azure or Amazon Web Services
- PaaS platforms

Cloud computing is growing rapidly. International Data Corporation expects public cloud spending to hit nearly \$500 billion by 2023.





What's the difference between on-premise and the cloud?

Essentially, the fundamental difference between cloud versus onpremise software is where your data resides.

On-premise software is installed locally, on your business computers, where cloud software is hosted on the vendor's server and accessed via a web browser or a resident applet.

On-premise software puts the user in control of their data allowing them full access to the data and added protection from internet failures.





Advantages of the Cloud



- Cost Utilizing the cloud doesn't require onsite servers.
- Mobility Cloud programs can be accessed anywhere with an internet connection.
- Back up and data storage Data is stored in offsite cloud servers and can be backed up.





Disadvantages of the Cloud



- <u>Reliability</u> Performance is based on internet service provider quality. Low bandwidth speeds limit reliability, service quality, and system performance.
- <u>Cost</u> Cloud services may be based on the amount of data stored and number of users. Storing more data can raise costs.
- <u>Hardware</u> Most Cloud-based companies don't provide technical support for hardware. Most peripherals require internet connection, which has its challenges.
- <u>Security/Risk</u> Your data is potentially stored with data from thousands of other businesses increasing the possibility of your data being hacked or compromised.
- <u>Compliance</u> HIPAA, PCI-DSS, GDPR, CCPA, and the Federal Firearms Act all require information protection compliance. Not all cloud service providers meet these compliance requirements.





Advantages of On Premise

- <u>Security</u> No comingling of data in cloud servers.
 Less chances of a data being breach. More securely protects sensitive business and consumer data.
- <u>Accessibility</u> Data is immediately available and completely under the control of the user.
- <u>Control</u> A business's data belongs to that business and is stored at that business.
- <u>Reliability</u> Store functions are not dependent on internet connection availability or quality.
- <u>Compliance</u> Because your data is stored locally, updated software keeps businesses fully compliant with regulatory and industry standards.
