

Retailing changes in 2020

- NielsenIQ data shows that 67% of all consumers say they changed the way they shop due to the pandemic.
- E-commerce sales grew over 32% in 2020.
- The number of purchases made online and picked up at stores increased by 208% in 2020.

- Paladin offers a myriad of integrations to easily add e-commerce to any store.
- Main purpose is to synchronize inventory and manage virtual sales in Paladin.
- Paladin supports multiple e-commerce platforms and offers an e-commerce API.


Paladin e-commerce for Ace



- Paladin is fully integrated with the Acehardware.com Order System (AOS) to support "buy online, pick up in store" (BOPIS) purchases.
- All in-store pickup transactions occur in AOS, and your Paladin database are updated automatically by Ace Hardware.
- In the Comparative Revenue reports, all instore pickup transactions are recorded in Paladin and will appear separately.
- All AceHardware.com invoices and on-hold quotes are stored and reported in Paladin.



Paladin e-commerce for Ace (continued)



How it works

- Before an order is placed When a customer searches for items online, the stock on hand for your store is always current because Paladin continuously updates Ace Hardware with your store's stock levels.
- After an order is placed for pickup at your store our AOS integration automatically puts the item **On-Hold** in Paladin.



Paladin e-commerce for Ace (continued)




How it works

- After the customer picks up the items - the store clerk enters the required information in AOS to confirm the customer received the items.
 - In the Paladin Inventory module under SOH History, an On-Hold entry appears to show the items have been received and are no longer on hold.
 - In the Invoice/Quote module, when Recall Transaction or F6 are clicked, the order information is no longer in the On-Hold details section.

How it works

- The invoice is available in the Recent Sale
 History viewer for Cash Sale invoices. The
 employee's name will be set to Paladin Batch.
 - Note: Recent AOS invoices can be accessed in the Invoice/Quote module. Click Advanced Look-up or press F1, click the History tab, and then select Invoice Reprint.
- In the **Reports** module, under **Comparative Revenue** reports, the AOS in-store pickup
 transactions are in the **WEBSTORE** category.
- AOS in-store pickup purchases also appear in the Transaction Report. Search for note: "ISPU"

- MOCE is the technical platform created by JK Specialty for Do It Best eCommerce integration.
- MOCE is a simple, easy-to-use e-commerce platform that allows stores to easily manage their online storefront.
- After the site launches, stores can update content anytime through the admin page.



Paladin-MOCE Do it Best



- All of Do it Best's 67,000 SKU's are ready to go with the integration.
- Custom SKUs can be added through Paladin.
- Pricing, inventory, special products offerings, and special pricing are all pulled in and updated from Paladin.
- MOCE enables uploads every 20 minutes.

Paladin-Spec 98 True Value



E-commerce for True Value

- True Value partners with EZ-AD to develop web stores.
- The True Value (Spec98)
 e-commerce integration sends True
 Value all required inventory data
- Paladin's stock-on-hand and price changes are automatically uploaded to keep a web store's stock-on-hand and pricing information up to date.



Paladin-Spec 98 True Value



- Stores can sync their Paladin POS system to have products immediately available on their e-commerce website.
- Product images and descriptions are already available in the e-commerce system.
- True Value (Spec98) automatically matches POS products to its database of over 8 million products.

Paladin-Ignitiv United Hardware



E-commerce for United Hardware

- United has partnered with <u>Ignitiv</u>, to provide a state-of-the-art e-commerce solution powered by <u>Kibo's</u> Unified Commerce platform.
- The integration gives United stores rich product information and the ability to check on product availability.



Paladin-Ignitiv United Hardware



- Inventory data is pushed and updated from Paladin to their web store every 24 hours.
- At a press of a button, Paladin clients can also manually upload their stock on hand and/or their full retail pricing.
- Store managers get the flexibility to communicate their offers and promotions.

Paladin-New Media Retailer House-Hasson



E-commerce for House-Hasson

- House-Hasson Hardware has partnered with New Media Retailer as its e-commerce provider.
- Paladin works with New Media Retailer to connect through the Paladin e-commerce API.
- House-Hasson retailers can now build and operate their online sale platforms with their Paladin database providing stock-onhand and online invoices.



Paladin's e-commerce API



Paladin e-commerce API



- The Paladin eCommerce API (application programming interface) allows any ecommerce platform to integrate with Paladin.
- The API provides methods to access and synchronize a store's inventory data in Paladin to create online invoices, manage pricing, and update stock on hand when online sales are made.

Paladin e-commerce API



- The API will create an invoice in Paladin and update the stock on hand.
- E-commerce sales are tracked in Paladin and reported on the comparative revenue report.



Volusion integration





- Volusion is an e-commerce platform that creates online shopping experiences.
- Paladin partners with Volusion to give stores the means and technology to grow their business through fully integrated online inventory, marketing, sales, and customer management.





- Paladin and Volusion allows stores to:
 - Keep stock-on-hand levels up to date. Whether a sale is made online or in-store, SOH amounts are synchronized in Volusion and Paladin.
 - Add or remove online store items. In the Inventory module, stores can select an item's Ext Sync checkbox to sell the product online. Clear the checkbox to remove the item from the online store.
 - Share item information online. When changes are made to Item descriptions, prices and other information in Paladin, the information is updated automatically in Volusion.





Paladin and Volusion allows stores to (continued):

- Track online sales in Paladin. When a customer purchases online, Paladin creates an invoice with the customer's name, item purchased, taxes, revenue and delivery info.
- Create customer accounts. A customer must create a user account to make an online purchase. When this happens, Paladin creates a customer account in the Customers module, and associates it with the invoice.





Paladin and Volusion allows stores to (continued):

• Handle items that are not in your normal inventory. An item in an online store that is not in a store's Paladin inventory, the invoice will use a generic part number and will record the item's online store part number description.

Note: Subscriptions to Paladin and Volusion are required to use both services.
