Facts about email

- By 2025, the number of email users is expected to reach 4.6 billion.
- 92% of the U.S. population reported using e-mails as a regular form of communication.
- More than 333 billion emails are sent and received each day.
- 64% of small businesses use email marketing to reach customers.

Email security

- The average employee gets 120 emails daily.
- This opens the door to cybercriminals who use email to attack businesses with malware, phishing campaigns, ransomware and more.
- Most cyberattacks 94% begin with a malicious email.
- Cybercrime cost businesses more than \$10.3 billion in 2022.

A Microsoft 365 subscription plans include a set of applications that help you get things done including staying connected and communicating with your vendors and customers.





How to get Paladin email license


- 1. Purchase Office 365 Exchange license.
- 2. Purchase a domain if store does not already have one.
- 3. Tie them together to create professional email.
- 4. Configure Paladin with new email.





GoDaddy resellers

- Paladin is a GoDaddy domain reseller.
- Paladin clients can purchase a domain from https://domains.paladinpos.com/
- One-time setup fee is \$150. The fee is waived if the domain in purchased from Paladin.





Paladin offers


- Apps for business = Desktop installs \$12
- Business Basic = Email license\$7.20
- Business Standard = Desktop installs + 1 Email license \$15
- Prices are subject to change





Paladin Email Manager options

- Paladin's Email Manager works simply.
 - Select an email address from the customer's or supplier email address list in Paladin.
 - Enter a new email address and send a receipt to that customer.
 - Send multiple emails before closing the window.
