




PO Module




PO Module



- These simple PO navigation tools are often missed:
 - Ctrl "F" or click on the binoculars image to search by part number, manufacture number, description 1 and 2, and by alternate part number.
 - F5 Recall Inventory jumps straight to the inventory item selected.



Stock check – multiple store check



- Stock check feature shows the available inventory in your suppliers' warehouse (most EDI suppliers supported).
- Remote Stock Check works in the following modules:
 - Invoice/Quote module
 - Inventory module
 - Purchase Order module
- **Note:** This feature has been extended to show your other single store stock-on-hand quantities on this same screen.



Inventory Module



Remove products from the suggested order




- How to remove products from the suggested order report.
 - Set Max Qty to zero and lock the padlock.
 - EDI will normally set the Order Qty to zero and lock the padlock.
- Either of these two methods will prevent products from autoordering when using the suggested order report.

Multiple core charges

File→Setup→Invoice(Store) tab



Multiple core charge types are supported in Paladin as classes.

- Add a generic core charge description in file/setup/Invoice(Store) tab under the "Use alternate core charge identifier".
- Set each core charge type as a new class.
- Add core charge and core charge class to products that require a core charge.
- Print core charges details report under Sales Analysis/What I need to Know/Core Charge Details.
- Optionally add an Auto-Text description.








Minimum margins



Minimum Margin



- Minimum margins will help your store stay profitable by protecting your margins in several areas.
 - When changing prices at checkout.
 - When adding discounts at checkout using F4 Discount button.
 - When creating sales and promotions.
 - When issuing rewards points.
 - When issuing prompt payment discounts on the statements.
- Minimum margins can be store wide across the board or set at the department level.



Serialization



Product serialization



- Product serialization is the process of assigning unique IDs or "serial numbers" to individual items in a product line.
- Serial numbers are useful in many scenarios including:
 - Managing warranty coverage
 - Maintaining ownership records
 - Supplier traceability & reporting
 - Service and repair tracking
 - Enhanced accountability




RF unit receiving serialized items


- The new 15-line RF Unit function provides the capability to scan or enter serial numbers during the receiving process.

Clearance management




PaladinNsight's Clearance management



- 1. In Paladin, from the top ribbon, select the **Inventory** module.
- 2. In the **PaladinNsight** dashboard, click any **magnifying glass** under each dial.
- In the Reviewer, select the Clearance tab.
- In the Clearance tab, in the Order By field, enable Department.
- 5. In the **Display By** field, enable **# of Items**.
- 6. Click the **magnifying glass** next to the department you want to view items from.




PaladinNsight's Clearance management (cont'd)



- After selecting a department, individual items can be chosen for clearance by simply clicking the checkbox on the left.
- Sort by any of the column headers such as, Last Sold, SOH, Retail Price, Unit Cost, etc.
- When you're ready to add these items to clearance, click the Clearance button on the bottom right-hand corner.
- As items are checked they will fall off the page and be added to a sale list.



PaladinNsight's new Clearance management (cont'd)



- At any time, an Excel report is available. Click the Excel Report button on the bottom right-hand corner.
- 2. The items for that department will appear in an Excel worksheet.



Clearance function



- Using the PaladinNsight[™] dashboard, clients can set up clearance items. The Clearance function automatically appears on the PaladinNsight dashboard for managers or other high-level employees.
- When the Item Overstock dynamic prompt is checked in the RF 15-line display options, the RF 15-line unit recognizes clearance items when in the Overwrite SOH or Append to SOH mode.

Selling on Consignment




What is selling on consignment

Consignment is an arrangement in which goods are left with a third party to sell. The party that sells the goods on consignment receives a portion of the profits, either as a flat rate fee or commission.

Paladin can help manage consignments by setting up a consignment department and customers, managing inventory, and organizing revenue and commission income reporting. The best approach is to add them as a supplier in Paladin. This makes it easier for tracking and reporting as well as managing their commission or percentage of sales.



Setting up a consignment department




To set up a department:

- In Paladin, from the main menu, select File > Setup.
- Select the **Dept** tab.
- In the **Departments** pane, under the **ID/Name** field, click **New**.
- Enter Consignment in the Name box.
- 5. In the **Department label number** box, enter a number that that exceeds existing department ID numbers. This will provide a method for segregating the consignment department when reporting.
- 6. Click **Save**, then click **Close**.




Adding a consignment item into inventory



- Select the **Inventory** module.
 - On the bottom ribbon, select **F2 Add Item**.
- In the **Add New Item** window, enter the information:
 - Part # Enter a part number that is unique.
 Tip: Preface with "C-" for quick searching.
 - Alt Part # If you want to auto-assign an alternate part number, click Next X #.
 - Description Enter a concise description of the item. For example: Clawfoot tub.
 - Cost Enter a zero. You will assign this item a margin percentage in a subsequent step.
 - Sell Price Enter the retail selling price.
 - SOH Enter zero.
 - Department From the list, select the consignment department.
 - Click F12 Add.



Establishing a reference margin for the new item




- 1. Open the **Pricing** tab.
- 2. In the **Pricing Levels** pane, add a price and a **Ref** margin.
- 3. Click **F12 Save** and exit the Inventory module.

The reference margin amount may be equal to the margin you will realize from the sale of this consignment item. For example, if you expect to get 50% of the purchase price and the other 50% goes to the consignment supplier, then the amount of the reference margin will be 50. Another example is if you expect to receive 40% of the purchase price and the other 60% goes to the consignment supplier, then the amount of the reference margin will be 40% or \$120, and the commission to the seller would be 60% or \$180.



Selling an item on consignment

- Select the **Invoice/ Quote** module.
- 2. Under **Part** number, enter the item's part number.
- Click F1 Adv. Lookup to get the part number.
 - 1. Search by **Keyword** or **Department**. For keyword you can begin the search with "C-" if part numbers were setup accordingly. As an option you can also search by the consignment department.
 - 2. Highlight the item, and under **QTY**, add a quantity.
 - Click Enter.
 - 4. Click F8 Add Items to Invoice



Selling an item on consignment (cont'd)

- On the bottom ribbon of the Invoice/Quote tab, click F8 Checkout.
- On the bottom ribbon of the Checkout tab, select a payment type and press Enter to complete the sale.







Reporting on consignment items and consignment customers/suppliers

There are several reports that can help track consignment items, including:

- Comparative Revenue Report
- Transaction Report
- Inventory Count List
- Inventory Master Report
- Inventory Summary Report




Little-known reports in Paladin






Itemized tax exemption transaction report



- This report generates a transaction report for any and all transactions that include a tax-exempt sale, whether it's a single line item or the entire invoice.
- Under Inventory, What I Need to Know, Transaction Report, enter the word "taxexempt" as the Customer Name on the additional settings field.




All Items Report



- This report generates a suggested order report but completely ignores the needs analysis. In other words, it prints all items determined by the Report Settings selection you choose.
- Under Inventory, purchase order, suggested order report, enter the word "allitems" in the beginning and ending field of part number.




Restricted items transaction report



- This report generates a transaction report for any and all transactions that include a stop-meth or restricted item.
- Under Inventory, What I Need to Know, Transaction Report, enter the word "mask" as the Customer Name on the additional settings field.




Items Sold Report – Replenishment ordering



- This report generates a sales history report of what was sold based on a date range and other criteria.
- This report enables you to generate a working purchase order from this data. The resulting purchase order can act as a foundation for ordering.
- Under Inventory, history, Items sold report, check the box "Create Purchase Orders from this data".



Other little-known reports



- Hourly Analysis Report
 - See when your store is the busiest and what hours may require more resources.
- Inventory Count List
 - Upside down margins.
 - Retail pricing by category.
 - Top 10 movers Top 100 movers.
 - Cycle counting assignments.
