




Instantly create ready-to-buy supplier purchase orders for suggested order items or a *purchase order without a selected supplier* with Order Analyst.















Items are split based on their Primary Supplier, **Supplier 1**.








After the individual supplier purchase orders are created, a completion message appears and the original and new purchase order names have the prefix **Split**.








### Purchase Orders: Order Analyst Part 2 (Best cost)


Compare supplier costs across your EDI systems automatically and always order from the lowest-cost EDI supplier with Order Analyst.

If only one EDI vendor exists on the inventory item, Order Analyst orders from the EDI vendor, whether it was cheaper than a non-EDI supplier or not.






### **Track Serial Numbers in Paladin**







Manager overrides for exceeded credit limits appear on invoices and in the Salesperson Exception Report.






### **Customers: Account Notes**

Add ongoing notes about a customer and maintain a historical record in their account.


A new account note feature lets you enter, review and exchange detailed, time-stamped notes about a customer with your accountant and other employees.

- Comparative Revenue report (Excel version) will automatically create individual worksheets for those specified groups.


### **Auto-print Yard Orders**

### **New Inventory Items Report**




- Track new items in your inventory with the New Inventory Items report in Excel.
